



Prize Giveaway

To Start:

Each guest is given a certain amount of play money. Everyone starts with the same amount. Players take their play money to any casino table and 'cash in' for chips. Chips can be taken from table to table. At the end of the gaming session, players will be 'colored up' by the dealers to the highest value chips and then directed to the Cashier's Station.

At the Cashier's Station:

Players will exchange their winnings for your prize giveaway.

Ways to Conduct Your Prize Giveaway:

Raffle of Prizes using Individual Prize Boxes – Cashier will add the total value of the player's chips. Using a ratio (1 Ticket / \$100.00), the cashier will exchange chips for raffle tickets (double sided raffle tickets are used). Players will keep 1 side of their raffle ticket and deposit the 2nd side into the prizes boxes associated with a prize they are interested in winning. Once all players have 'cashed-out' and deposited their tickets, you can begin your giveaway by selecting the winning ticket from each prize box.

Comments: This process is great if you want to allow players to choose the prizes they are most interested in winning.

Raffle of Prizes using Raffle Drum – Cashier will add the total value of the player's chips. Using a ratio (1 Ticket / \$100.00), the cashier will exchange chips for raffle tickets (double sided raffle tickets are used). Players will receive 1 side of their raffle tickets. The Cashier will place the 2nd side into the raffle drum. Once all players have 'cashed-out', the cashier will deliver the raffle drum to you to begin your giveaway by selecting the winning ticket from the raffle drum.

Comments: This process is great if all prizes are similar in nature.

Biggest Winner(s) – Cashier will add the total value of the player's chips. On a piece of paper (or using computer), the Cashier will note each player's name and the total amount of their winnings. Once all players have 'cashed-out', the cashier will rank the players from Highest Value to Lowest Value (for as many prizes as you have) and deliver the list to you to begin your giveaway.

Comments: This process is the easiest to conduct and puts emphasis on how well your players did at the casino tables.

Combination Raffle & Biggest Winner – Combination of Raffle of Prizes (using either Individual Prize Boxes or Raffle Drum) and Biggest Winner described above.

Comments: This process is great if you have 1 Grand Prize (Biggest Winner) and various other prizes.

Auction - Cashier will exchange chips for Play Money. Once all players have 'cashed-out', you can begin auctioning your prizes to the Highest Bidder.

Comments: This process is the most difficult but good for "teams".
